 - Local Safety Projects MDT
 - <u>SF 159 Lola & Shepard Way Intersection Imp</u> new signal on US-12 at Shephard Way and roundabout at Lola ST. Anticipated construction in 2025.
 - <u>SF 149 Lincoln Applegate Intersection</u> roundabout at the intersection of Lincoln Road and Applegate Drive. Anticipated construction in 2025.
 - <u>SF 179 Helena Intx Safety</u> safety improvements at Prospect and Gibbon, Lincoln Rd and Glass Drive, and Lincoln Road and Hauser Dam Rd. Tentative 2024 construction.

 - <u>Lincoln Road Montana Avenue to I-15</u> Roundabouts and additional southbound on-ramp. Awarded to Helena Sand and Gravel. Interchange ramp work and roundabout CN in progress. Come back and finish in 2023.
 - Wolf Cr N&S I-15 rehabilitation from MP 222.0 to 229.1. Awarded 2022, Spring 2023 & 2024 construction.
 - <u>E of East Helena East</u> (CN 8684) Passing lanes and turn lanes on US-12 east of Diehl Ranch Road to Spokane Creek Road. Awarded to Riverside Contracting. Come back and chip seal in 2023.
 - <u>Lincoln Road W of Green Meadow</u> Reconstruction of S-279 from Green Meadow Drive to Birdseye Road. Alignment should be finalized soon. Anticipated construction 2028.
 - <u>Custer Avenue Signals Helena</u> Upgrade traffic signals & ADA. Anticipate 2024 construction.
 - Sieben Interchange North Rehab on I-15 from RP 217.5 to 222.0. Anticipate 2026 construction.
