I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

An email dated March 5, 2024, contained updates to the Sierra Park grant request budget. The changes in the budget require changes to the staff report dated February 26, 2024. This memo serves to update the staff report to reflect those changes.

REQUEST:

The Applicant is seeking \$28,625.00 for improvements and maintenance from the Parks Development Fund to reimburse the Sierra Park Board.


The budget is calculated in the table below based on the email dated March 5, 2024.

Based on an updated budget in an email dated March 5, 2024. The total cost of the project is \$40,000.00. The funding request is for \$28,625.00 and the remainder of \$11,375.00 would be funded with \$10,575.00 from the Sierra Park Board fund, and \$800.00 in donated materials.

The 2017 Lewis and Clark County Parks and Recreation Plan provides a map of the Helena Valley Park Planning Area which is divided into five park fee areas provided below. The park lies within the Northwest Valley Park Fee Area and the balance in that funding area is \$13,050.00. This project is for a regional park and many residents throughout the Helena Valley Park Planning Area use this park for recreation. The request for \$28,625 will come from multiple fee areas. On the following page provides a table showing the balance in each fee area and the two requests for funding that we currently have.

I have been simply buried in travel, meetings, and work projects these past few weeks. Now that I review this again I see where I screwed up so badly. I conflated total cost and match from the meeting minutes on the first item and never recovered – and kept numbers artificially lower for other two categories as result. I was trying to get to \$30,000 in left column, when total should have been \$40,000. Very sorry. As a result, I totally low-balled estimated costs for seeding and irrigation of new area. Given late hour - asking your help to present the figures below as the actual estimates of what we think TOTAL costs will be for the specific projects, along with the 25% match... all numbers should make a lot more sense now.

Budget should specify following:

Irrigation System — Total cost - \$14,000, Sierra Park/School District account match - \$3,500 Monitor and Repair Existing Sprinkler System — Total Cost - \$3,000, Sierra park/School District account match - \$750

Extending irrigation and seeding for 1.5 additional acres - Total Cost \$20,500; Sierra Park School District match - \$5,125

Crushed granite trail and field work - Total cost - \$2,500; Sierra Park School District match- \$625
