## C & D Roll-off Information:

- Rate of \$240.45 for 20, 30 or 40 yard
  - 5 tons included in cost
    - Tonnage over 5 tons billed at current C&D rate of \$23/ton\*\*
  - 30 day rental included in cost
    - Monthly rental charge of \$50/month past 30 days
- Material must be C & D waste
  - Solid Waste Supervisor will complete a Site Inspection
  - See list below for acceptable debris

\*\*C&D rate subject to change

### **Do Not Overfill Container**

C & D Waste cannot extend past the sides and top of container.

Overfilled Containers will not be serviced until material is properly re-arranged.

#### UNACCEPTABLE CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION

ARM 17.50.511 (3)(b) Liquid Paints, solvents, glues, resins, dyes, oils, pesticides, and other household hazardous waste must be removed from building prior to demolition.

We will not take: Regulated hazardous waste, liquids, asbestos, any flammable, corrosive or volatile waste, or wood treated with pentachlorophenol.
