

All boulevard trees shall be protected during construction and evaluated/monitored by City of Helena's Park and Recreation Department (447-8485). Do not cut, prune, damage or remove <u>ANY PART INCLUDING ROOTS</u> of a public tree without approval of the department. Contractor understands all public trees shall be protected per City Ordinance 7-10. Initial

PROVIDE A TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN IN AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT AND THE 24 HOUR TRAFFIC CONTROL MAINTAINERS CONTACT INFORMATION (Name: \_\_\_\_\_\_\_).

On collector or higher classified streets, the street opening will be limited to 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. If a multiday closure is required the trench shall be backfilled each night, so the street can be open to traffic after 4:30 PM and not closed again until 8:30 AM. Initial

-All work within City ROW must comply with The City of Helena's City Code.

-All work within City ROW must comply with The City of Helena's Engineering Standards and Specifications and current ADA Standards regardless of any section specifically called out in the application.

Winter Installs – Temporary patches will be allowed, when hot mix asphalt is not available, shall consist of a minimum 6" of compacted road mix capped with a minimum of 6" of 2 sack concrete slurry. Cold mix asphalt can be used on a case-by-case basis as approved by the City Engineering Department. All temporary patches shall be replaced with hot mix asphalt as soon as hot mix asphalt is available. Additional flowable fill or washed rock maybe required on collector or higher classified streets.

Any sidewalk closed for more than seven (7) days shall have an alternate route constructed per City Code and approved by City Engineering.
