NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Project Limits:

Nine (9) locations throughout the City, including 3 City parks and the golf course. Please see the map on the reverse side of this flyer.

Project Description:

This project will drill 9 test wells to determine geology and water capacity for potential public water supply wells.

Schedule:

Drilling is scheduled to begin the week of November 27, 2023, at test well 9 across from the Missouri River Water Treatment Plant. Each well will take 7-10 days to complete.

Additional Information:

We are dedicated to causing as little impact to you as possible, however, there will be noise caused by the drilling activities. Some park amenities may not be accessible during construction.

The Contractor's work area will have temporary fencing to provide security and safety to the public. Please use caution near the construction site.

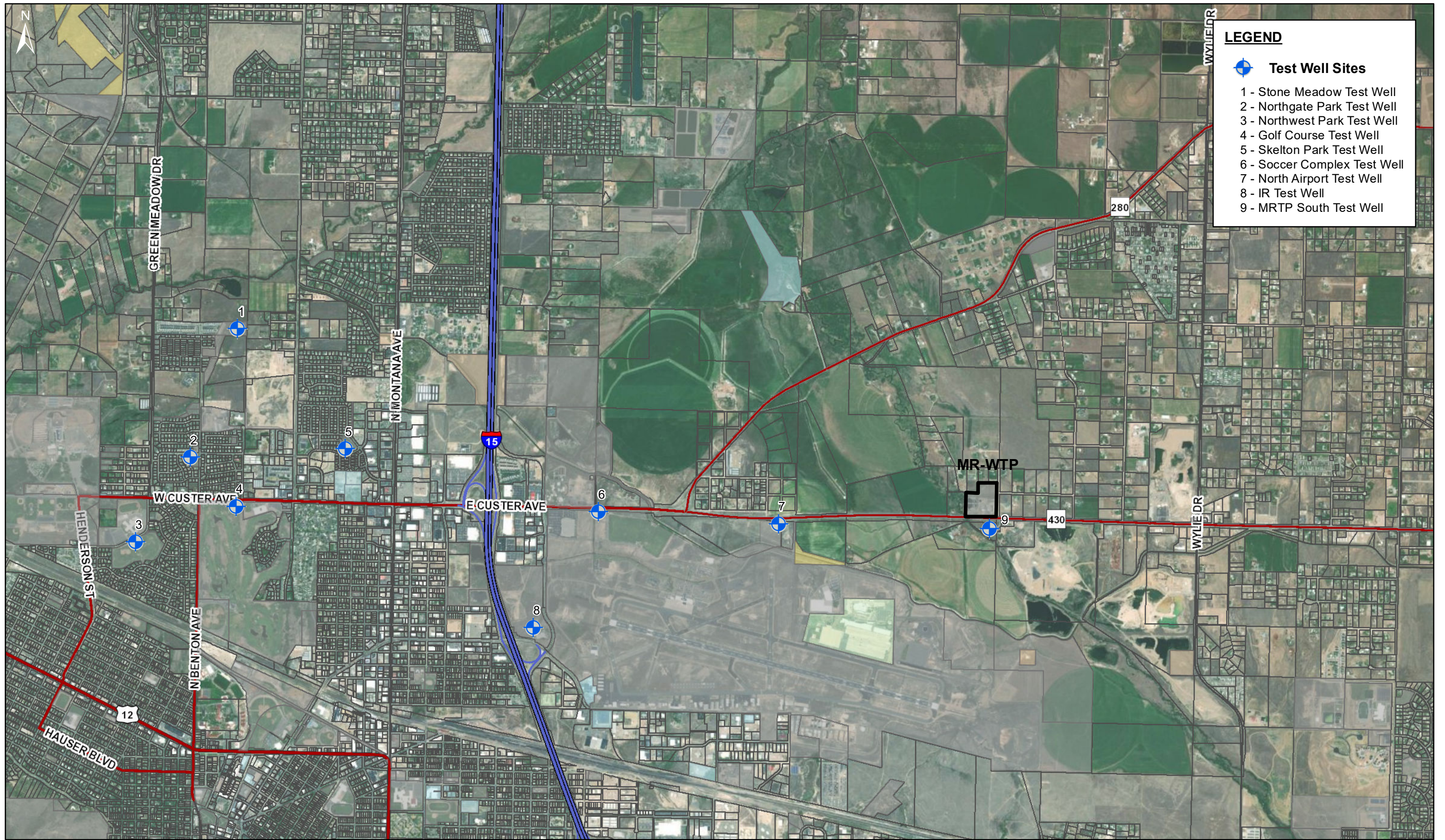

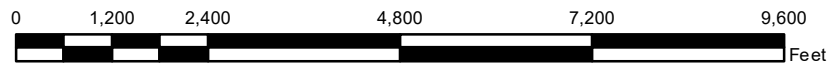
